The A/B pass rate is 55.9% which is a 0.9% improvement on last year and is a new record for Tomlinscote. A/B/C pass rate is 81.2% (79% in 2008) and again a record, with an A – E pass rate of 99.5%.

One student obtained four A Grades, and six students gained three A Grades.

It should be remembered that almost all students will have achieved an additional AS Level qualification in Year 12.
