As a general guide Year 7 homework should be 30 minutes for each subject, Year 8 – 30 to 40 minutes and in Year 9 - 45 minutes. In Year 7, History and Geography homework may be set on alternate weeks and RE homework is set every two weeks in Years 7, 8 & 9. Science appears twice each week but may only be set once per week rotating between members of staff and the topic.
