What an achievement.

Sophie Lewis is ranked 39th in the **world** at U17. This was her first trampoline world's competition which took place in Russia. 45 nations took part, 74 competed in Sophie's age group, U17. She looked really good in warm-up and was feeling ok despite being literally first up of the 74. Unfortunately on her arm set (last bounce signalling start of routine) her knee gave way so her take off for the first double wasn't good - she fought hard to stay on and regain control, changing the fifth double for a simpler straight back and then finished the last five moves in near perfect style with just .1 deductions. She finished a very meritable 39th, but knows realistically she could have made top 20.

Sophie went into the event as **4th ranked GB girl but finished 2nd**. She had a fantastic time and met the world's greatest ever trampolinist - Alex Moskalenko - as well as making loads of new international friends. An American won the U17 girls and Sophie persuaded her to swap her jacket for Sophie's GB training jacket - so she's got the World Champion's jacket - the best souvenir ever!!!!
